


DC Health Matters Connect is an online directory where you can search and connect with free or reduced cost social service programs in the Washington, DC metropolitan area. DC Health Matters Connect provides a straightforward way to find social services in our community and connect to them directly and electronically in every ZIP Code across the United States. Services and programs on the directory include federal, state, county, municipal, and local resources across the metropolitan area and the nation. DC Health Matters Connect was created to ensure that all residents are able to find appropriate and accessible resources to meet their needs. The platform provides open and free searches to allow *everyone* (whether it be a health care provider, a case manager, or a community member) to connect to appropriate and available services in our area. DC Health Matters Connect also supports nonprofits by allowing them to join the platform for free and provide free screening tools to encourage them to help people seeking help on the network.



- Search based on zip code and need (Ex: food, transportation, housing, goods)
- Refine search results
 - Personal filters
 - Program filters
 - Income Eligibility
- Connect with a program (Print, email, call, electronic referral)





What are the benefits?

DC Health Matters Connect can supplement existing care coordination programs, bolster the social work team, act as a knowledge repository for staff, be a sideline tool for the case management team, and act as a catalyst to implement a population-wide screening and connection program.

This site can be shared with community members, referrers (those working directly with community members to address social needs), CBOs, health care providers, anyone -- folks all over the DC community have free access.

Provider/CBO usage: to search on behalf of clients, make referrals, and accept referrals

Community members: to search for resources themselves

DC Health Matters Connect is run by DC Health Matters Collaborative, a group of non-profit hospitals, community health centers, and other city partners who embrace a vision of one healthy and thriving capital city that holds the same promise for all residents regardless of where they live.
